


## NASA OKSG Speedfest India Class 2020-2021 "Take-off" Event















WHAT?

The NASA OKSG is hosting the Speedfest India Class 2021-2022 "Take Off educator event for both educators who have already registered a team in this year's Speedfest and those who are considering the opportunity for the 2021-2022 school year. During this event, participating educators will learn the rules/requirements for Speedfest 2022, be immersed in the hands-on inquiry-based Speedfest Curriculum created by the NASA OKSG (designed to teach the concepts leading up to the plane build), have the opportunity to tour various OSU MAE labs/facilities, and receive plane kits.
